

#### **BAILIES OF BENNACHIE 2021 AGM ZOOM MEETING**



1. Welcome	The meeting was held online by zoom on 14 June 2021 from 7.30pm and was chaired by Jackie Cumberbirch, who welcomed members
	and friends to the meeting as per the above participant list.
	Jackie explained that the AGM was normally held during March, but this was delayed as it was preferred to have a face-to-face meeting.
	The decision to hold the AGM by zoom was taken as there was no indication of government guidelines easing to allow an actual meeting.
2. Minutes of 2020 AGM	The minutes of the previous AGM, held on 29 June 2020, were adopted unopposed.
3. Accounts for 2020	Brian Cornock (Bailies treasurer) asked if there were any queries about the 2020 accounts which had been submitted to OSCR and are available for the public to see on OSCR's website.
	The figures highlighted in the annual report to members (and as further explained in a pdf pack distributed online before this AGM) were an income of £10,332 and expenditure of £15,572 with the balance of £5240 coming from reserves.
	At year end 31 Dec 2020, the reserves were £129,561.
	Peter Kellas raised a question regarding why there were higher website costs over the last 2 years. This was explained as being related to the new website costs in the first year and the fun – learning section added in the last year.

5. Election of Trustees	As required in the Constitution, the 14 incumbent trustees, Ann Baillie, Brian Cornock, Jackie Cumberbirch, Margaret Garden, Angela Groat, William Linklater, Dave Peter, Donna Taylor, Andrew Wainwright, Dan Montgomery, Peter Stock, Alex Doig, Lorna Bell and Alan Henderson stood down.

	Brian Cornock had intimated he did not wish to offer himself for re-election and was retiring as a Trustee and the Bailies Treasurer. Jackie
	then thanked Brian for over 16 years of service to the Bailies not only as a trustee but in particular to his role as Treasurer which he carried
	out with diligence and professionalism.
	The remaining 13 trustees offered themselves for re-election for a further annual term and were re-elected unopposed.
	A call was made for new trustees and there were no volunteers.
	This led to a total of 13 trustees for the 2021/2022 term, i.e., until the next AGM (normally held around the time of the Spring equinox in
	late March).
	Jackie explained that the appointment of roles for the new team of 13 trustees would be decided at the first post-AGM meeting of the
	trustees, expected to be held by zoom or face to face on 12 July 2021.


